**Barton** is on the B655 about 6 miles from Hitchin, close to the A6 and about 2 miles from the M1 junction 12. Approaching from Hitchin, Church Road is the first turning left after reaching the Barton sign. From the other direction it's the third turning right after the village hall. For *multimap.com* users the postcode is MK45 4LA.

**Please bring** something to sit on - garden chairs, rugs or the like. Some people bring a picnic hamper. Toilet facilities are in the Church Hall adjacent to the venue.

**Cars can't park** on the B655 nor in Church Road which is very narrow. There are 30 spaces at the venue on Friday and Saturday and 70 at the Arnold Middle School which is a few minutes walk from the venue. The school is opposite the Barton sign approaching from Hitchin. When the venue car park is full, cars will be directed to the school. Please try to share a car.

**Bad weather.** In the event of serious rain, such as happened in 2009, the event will be staged at the Queen Mother Theatre, Hitchin. The box office answering service on 01462 455166 will be updated daily with an announcement about that day's performance.
